Handling Glucose buffer solution contains 0.4% concentration of sodium azide. This is a poisonous chemical. When diluting this solution (50 ml) in 1 litre of water, it is essential to wear protective gloves and glasses. The final concentration of sodium azide in the reagent used is 0.02%.

Powdered enzymes should be handled with care and under precautions to avoid inhalation of dust. Airborne dust or aerosols can develop during spillage, material transfers or vigorous stirring of solutions. Any operation which might create dust or aerosol should take place in areas that are provided with adequate exhaust or other forms of mechanical control systems. It is important to avoid direct contact with skin. Rubbing of the face or eyes should be avoided when wearing protective gloves that have been in contact with enzyme.
